Morris Airport Construction News

The parking lot project at Morris Airport began last month and is projected to take about six weeks to complete. In the meantime, parking is limited to the south lot. You may park at the north end of the south lot for the shortest walk to BSA planes.

Starting in September construction will begin on a PAPI! From what I understand the inclusion of a PAPI may win approval from the FAA to now allow IFR approaches at night! There are also plans for more T-hangars, which is a much-needed resource in the area flying community.

With the exciting addition of more hangars and a PAPI, I inquired if the city incorporated plans for a facility at Morris Airport to provide space for a Flight School and/or maintenance shop, but unfortunately at this point they did not.
